Students will also have frequent opportunities to take part in subject related trips both in the UK and abroad.

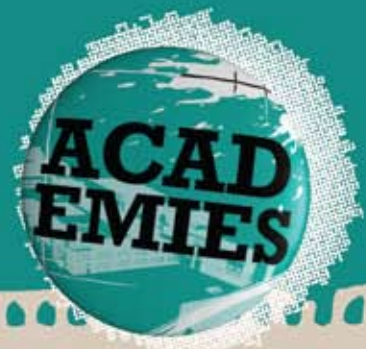




SMC ACADEMIES
